The bearer of this document, travelling on Qantas/Jetstar Group aircraft, has been issued operator (airline) approval to carry lithium battery powered equipment, including up to two spare batteries provided the following are met.

**CARRIAGE REQUIREMENTS (will be verified at the time of Check-In)**

**Portable Medical Equipment**

1. The ON/OFF switch on all devices must be protected from accidental activation.
2. Devices are permitted in checked or carry-on baggage.
3. You must present this approval whenever you check-in.

**Spare Batteries (101-160Wh)**

No more than two spare batteries are permitted per passenger.

1. All the terminals must be individually protected from short circuit e.g. taped, individual plastic bags etc.;
2. Spare batteries are only permitted in carry-on baggage.

**NOTE:** There is no quantity restriction for spare lithium batteries with a watt-hour rating less than 100Wh. They must still be packed in carry-on baggage only with the terminals insulated. Carry-on baggage limits apply

It is the sole responsibility of the passenger travelling to ensure any additional international/national requirements and any other operator (airline) approvals are obtained prior to travel.
