ESZTER CSEPELI, HCA is Hungary's leading female cinematographer. She is a founding member of the Hungarian Cinematographers' Association (HCA) and the only woman on the board. Over 15 years, she was the only Hungarian woman to film a feature film as a cinematographer. Eszter is a Fulbright Scholar and nominated for Palme d'Or at Cannes Film Festival. ZEISS + WIM Altitude Awards Winner, Main Prize. Featured in British Cinematographer. She currently resides in Los Angeles. She was selected for the ASC Mentorship Program in 2022, her mentor is Cynthia Pusheck ASC.

BENEDICT SPENCE, BSC started his career in Factual Entertainment, as a lighting camera person in the early 2000's. Slowly moving over into commercials and drama work, he has been a cinematographer for the past 10 years. Today he works both in High End TV, and commercials. In 2020 he was nominated for an Emmy Award for his Cinematography on Netflix's *The End Of The F**cking World*, and in 2023 he was asked to join the British Society of Cinematographers.
