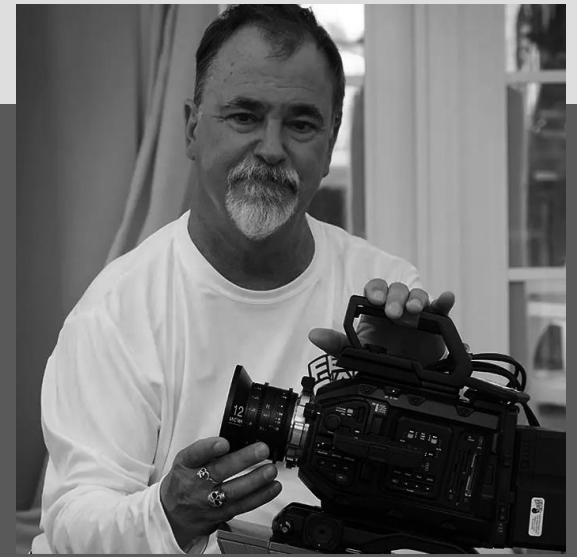

PEDRO LUQUE, SCU
Director of Photography

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Pedro Luque, a graduate of the Uruguayan Film School, has been working as a director of photography since 2005. He was the director of photography for the documentaries Palabras Verdaderas (True words), La Matinée, Cachila, Hit, and Mundialito, and for the feature films El Cuarto de Leo (Leo's room), Miss Tacuarembó, La Casa Muda (The Silent House), and Dios Local. Based in Los Angeles, he did the photography for Dermaphoria, directed by Ross Clarke, and the HBO series The Hypnotist, as well as for Fede Álvarez's films No respire (Don't Breathe) and La Chica en la web (The Girl in the Spiders Web). In June 2018 he was invited as a member of the Academy of Film and Cinematographic Arts of Hollywood. Winner of the Goya Award of the Spanish Film Academy for the cinematography of la Sociedad de la Nieve (Society of the Snow), directed by J.A. Bayona.

Amortegui photography appears across television series including: Syfy's Resident Alien; Netflix's Worn Stories; Warner Bros - TV/The CW's Black Lightning; BET's Twenties; feature documentaries Heat; Imagining Zootopia for the Fusion Network, as well as commercials for Disney and the United Nations.

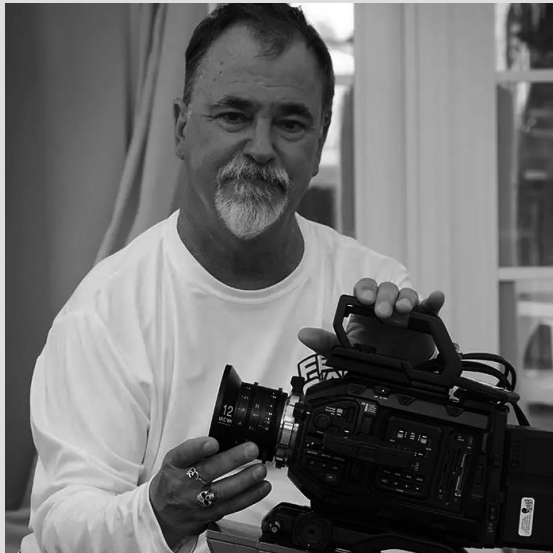


ERIC HASSO VFX Director
